



Volunteer Opportunities

Outreach/ Prevention Education Tabling Crew



(June- September) (6positions)

Hang out with PCAF staff at community festivals like Out in the Park and Freedom Fair, talk to people about the work PCAF does and how to keep themselves safe, Build safer-sex packets, promote the AIDS Walk.

Direct Mailing Campaign



(July & August) (unlimited postions)

Alert the Public to the AIDS Walk, learn from experienced volunteers, join the bulk mail party, with good food, good music and great company.

Essential Needs Delivery



(Ongoing, beginning in August) (2 positions)

Deliver Toiletry and personal health items to PCAF clients. Must have reliable transportation and valid license and insurance. Gas mileage will be reimbursed by PCAF.

AIDS Walk Street Team



(July) (unlimited positions)

Build the Buzz for the AIDS Walk, Hang posters, talk to local businesses, distribute Walk brochures, work in teams with friends, family and other volunteers.

Food Program Assistant



(Monday's staring in July) (2 positions)

This is an on-going Weekly assignment. Unload and organize the food bags, help distribute nutritious meals to PCAF clients.

Transportation Assistance



(ongoing, weekdays only) (five positions)

Use your day off to help PCAF clients get around to the grocery store, the PCAF office, or to doctor's appointments. Must have reliable transportation and valid license and insurance. Gas mileage will be reimbursed by PCAF.

AIDS Walk Materials Preparation



(June-August) (6 positions)

Work closely with PCAF staff to help us prepare for our biggest fundraiser of the year. Make buttons, organize street team materials, cut ribbons and stickers, gather supplies.

Walk Day Preparations Team



(August 20th - September 5th) (6 positions)

Assist PCAF staff and other volunteers in finalizing the preparations for the AIDS Walk. Build advocacy and informational signs for use on the Walk route; assemble First AID kits for route monitors, inventory and load all Materials for the walk site.

Day of the Walk Volunteer



(September 6th) (unlimited positions)

Directly impact the success of the AIDS Walk by helping it run smoothly, there are many different jobs to do on Walk day. If you are planning to volunteer at the AIDS Walk, please let Beth know to discuss what positions are available to you.
